Training Program – Emergency Medical Responder (EMR – M1)



Definition - Emergency Medical Responder

Emergency Medical Responders provide immediate lifesaving care to critical patients who access the emergency medical services system. EMRs have the knowledge and skills necessary to provide immediate lifesaving interventions while awaiting additional EMS resources to arrive. **EMRs** also provide assistance to higher-level personnel at the scene of emergencies and during transport. Emergency Medical Responders are a vital part of the comprehensive EMS response. Under medical oversight, Emergency Medical Responders perform basic interventions with minimal equipment.

Training : Consists theory lessons & practical training sessions

Medium : Conducted in only one language at a time (Sinhala /English/ Tamil)

1. MCI management.
2. Basics of TRIAGE.
3. Air way & Oxygen therapy/ suction.
4. Using AMBU (Bag & Mask) ventilation.
5. AED & Chest compressions.
6. Controlling serious bleeding & use of tourniquet.
7. Basics of Spinal Injury & transport
8. Handling amputation Injury & Crush Injury.
9. Basics of Diabetic coma & CNS emergencies.
10. Basics of fracture management & immobilization.
11. Moving patients - using various type of stretchers – folding/ Scoop/ Spinal Board / wheel chair.
12. Loading & unloading patients from an Ambulance / vehicle.
13. Basic of Medical ethics - privacy / protecting information / relationship with patients & etc.
14. Familiarization to Ambulance & equipment.

Eligibility for Certificate: 100% attendance.

Assessment: Individual assessment will be done during training sessions.
